**SUMMER CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT**



We all want to have a fun, happy, safe, memorable learning experience at Science is Everywhere Summer Camp. In order to ensure all these things, we have outlined a few expectations. It is each camper's responsibility to follow the policies and expectations listed below. Parents and guardians: please review them with your camper and sign the bottom of the form.

- I will follow instructions from camp and museum staff and volunteers, as well as guest speakers.
- I will always remain within sight of a camp leader.
- I will resolve problems positively. If I need help, I will ask a volunteer or counselor to help me.
- I will be a friend to others and care for, include, help and encourage others in my camp. I will give turns and share with others.
- I will keep my hands and feet to myself at all times. I understand that there is ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY FOR HITTING AND BULLYING.
- I will use polite words in an appropriate voice.
- I will not bring or use any form of weapons, tobacco, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, or fireworks while at camp.
- I will respect all property including the camp facilities, furniture, equipment and museum exhibits, as well as the property of others. Unless I am given specific permission by the camp staff, I will leave camp supplies at camp. When outside the classroom, I will be respectful of visitors to the museum and not run.
- I will participate in camp activities and help to keep the camp classrooms neat and clean for others.
- I will not use my cell phone or electronic devices during instruction and camp activities unless directed to by my camp instructor. I understand I should talk to my camp instructor if I need to use my phone. The museum is not responsible for lost, stolen or broken items.
- I understand that some campers and camp staff have requested to not have their image publicized. I will respect others' privacy and not take photographs or videos of camp staff, campers or museum visitors to post on social media. If I wish to photograph or videotape a camp activity, I will ask permission from the camp instructor.

*Following these expectations ensures that our summer campers have good time and remain safe. Campers who do not adhere to the expectations will be counseled by the Camp Assistant. Camp staff reserve the right to contact the guardians of, or dismiss any child whose behavior violates this code of conduct and becomes a safety risk to themselves, other campers or staff. No refunds will be given in the event of dismissal due to failure to adhere to expectations.*
